### **END OF TERM ARRANGEMENTS**

### Last Week of Term w/c 8 July

Please note there are no after school activities or study in the last week of term, with the school day finishing at 4pm and early coaches in operation departing Senior Boys at 4.25pm each day Monday 8 July through to Thursday 11 July. Boys will be asked to clear their lockers and take all items home, leaving them unlocked for cleaning over the break. Padlocks will be cut off any lockers left locked.

### Last Day of Term - Thursday 11 July - 4pm finish

On the last day of term all boys should come into school wearing their PE/games kit. The morning will be spent doing report reflections, updating PPPs/PAPs and in assemblies. Boys will need their chromebook, pencil case and water bottle. The afternoon will be spent at games for Years 7 to 9 and there will be a TaskMaster quiz at school for Year 10.

- Results will be sent electronically at approximately 8.15am to your son's school gmail account
- Teaching staff will be available from 9-10am at Senior Girls/Sixth Form (College Avenue SL6 6AW) for boys who wish to come in to get their printed results slip and meet with fellow pupils
- Mr Hope, Head of Sixth Form, will be available from 9am to sign up for your Sixth Form Course Choice options
- If printed results slips are not collected by 11am they will be posted home
- Collection of results by someone else other than the candidate will only be permitted if the <u>Permission to Collect a Candidate's Results form</u> is completed and returned to <u>puc@clairescourt.net</u> by Friday 12 July
