Parking outside School

May we politely ask that for the safety of our pupils you do not wait on the double yellow lines on College Road. The double yellow lines are there to ensure visibility is maintained thereby keeping both pedestrians and drivers safe. The traffic wardens do patrol the area and will issue tickets for cars parked illegally on double yellow lines.

Additionally, our coach drivers have requested that cars **do not stop or wait on the zig zag lines outside school or opposite the school gate** as this makes
