UNIFORM REMINDER

- **Skirts** The skirt must be on the knee and is now our all year round skirt which can be worn without tights in the summer.
- **Hair** must be of a natural colour, and in a ponytail if longer than shoulder length. Please remove any fabric braids that may have been put in whilst on holiday.
- **Earrings** pupils may wear two pairs of plain circular studs cartilage and nose piercings are not allowed and pupils will be told to remove them. No other jewellery is permitted.
 - If your child is planning on having their ears pierced, please ensure this happens at the start of the summer holidays to allow for the advised **6 week healing process**. Please note jewellery or piercings of any kind are not permitted for PE/Games/sports fixtures. Pupils are **not** permitted to tape earrings in line with AfPE guidance, therefore please ensure piercings happen early in the summer holidays to allow full participation in the curriculum from September onwards.
- **Make-up** is not allowed in Year 7-9 and only light, discreet make-up in Year 10-11. False nails and eyelashes are not allowed and pupils will be asked to remove them.
- Coats you may wear a Claires Court branded coat to and from school

and also throughout the school day over your blazer during the colder months. If your coat is not a Claires Court branded coat then you may wear it to and from school but it must be put away in your locker once you arrive.

During the school day pupils do not need to be outside during lunchtimes and break times as they can access the dining hall and chapel at all times, and the hall at break times. Therefore coats during the school day should not be required.


If you would like to attend and have not reserved seats, there are limited seats remaining for **Wednesday night only**, so please contact your school office to enquire.
