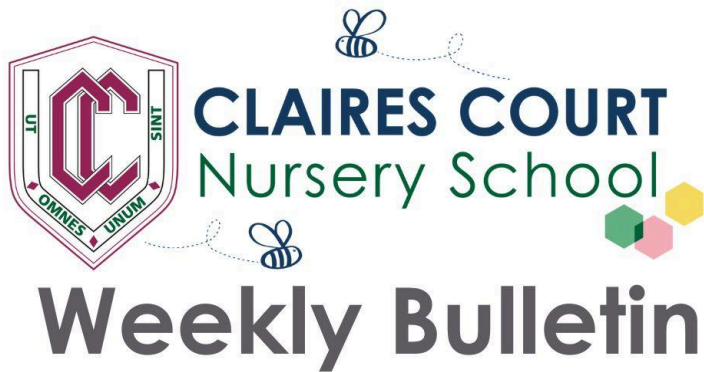

Storytime with Chris

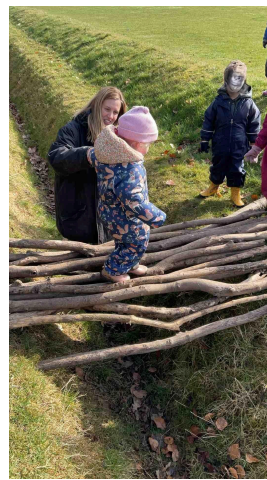
