#### **Update to Claires Court Sports Kit**

We would like to let you know that we are changing some of the sports kit from September 2025. The key reasons for these changes are to:

- create a more unified appearance across all four divisions of the school
- reduce the amount of white kit
- streamline the number of items required.

This will make the kit more versatile across different sports, ultimately helping to reduce costs for families. The new kit will be available for purchase from Hawkinsport from May/June 2025 with a gradual transition to adopt all new items by the start of the Autumn term in September 2026. #### Scientific Calculator - for the Summer Term

Pupils in Year 7 and 8 currently complete non-calculator work in Mathematics, but the IGCSE examination papers are both calculator only, and so in the last term of Year 8 we like to start looking at calculator skills and topics which require a calculator. With this in mind, your son will need a scientific calculator for his Maths lessons from Easter onwards. Our strong recommendation is that the best calculator for the IGCSE studies is the Casio FX-83GTCW, as it has the best functionality and ease of input for pupils.


